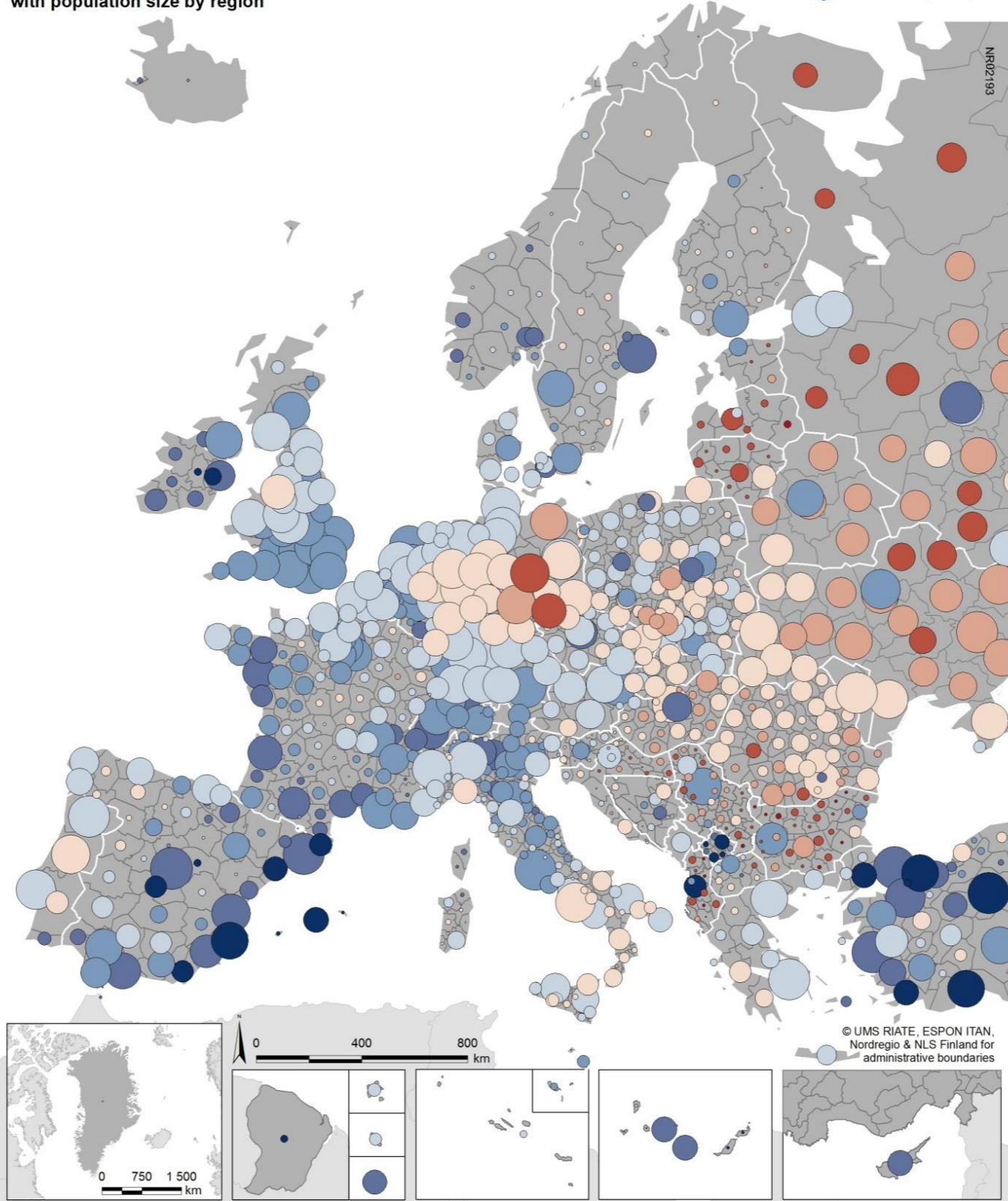

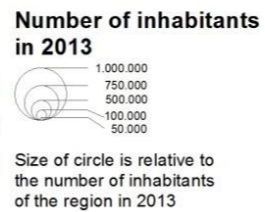
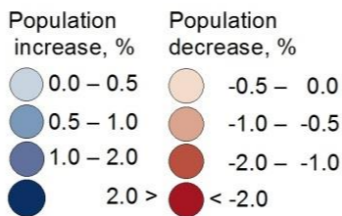

at regional level*



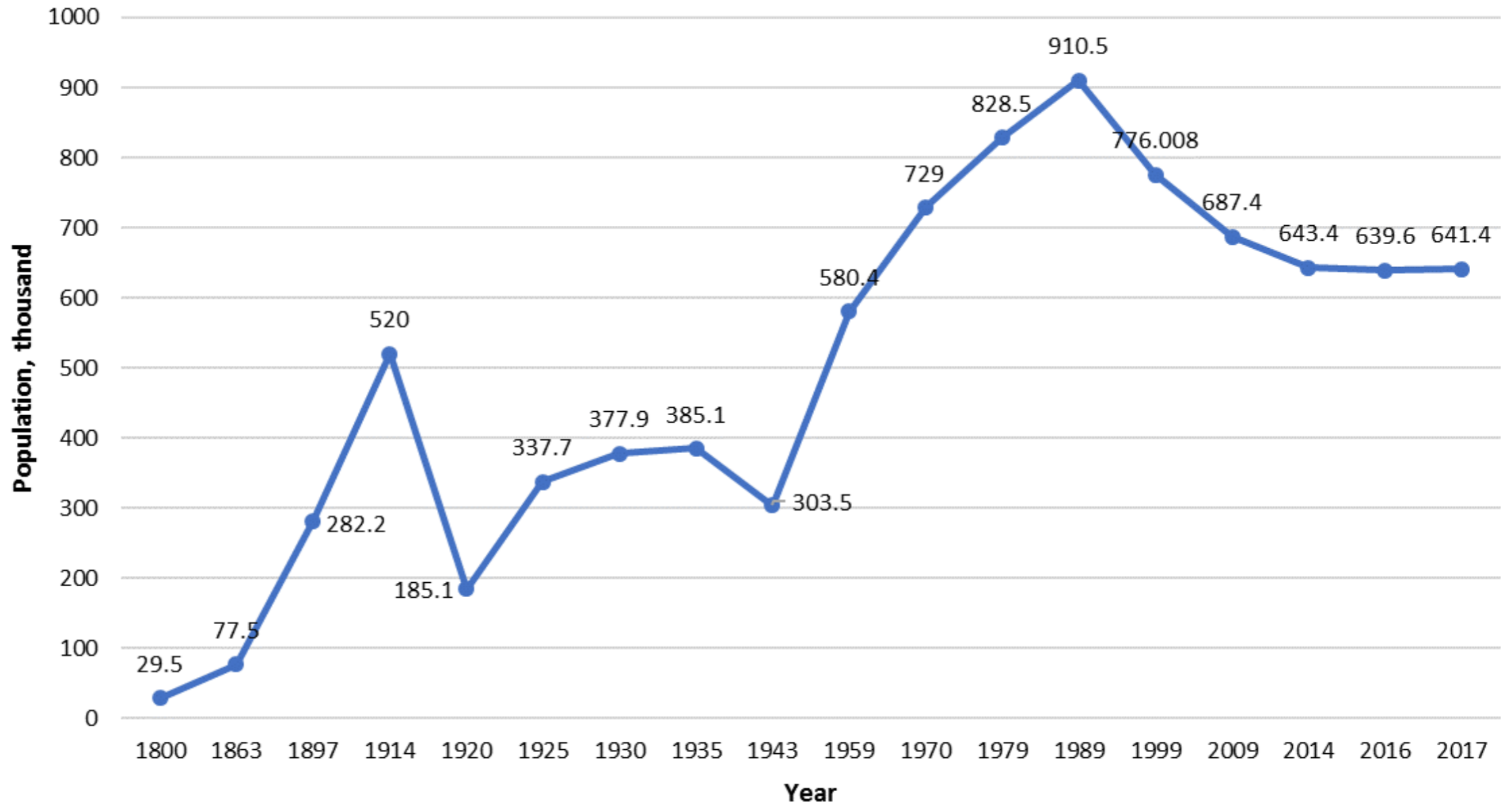

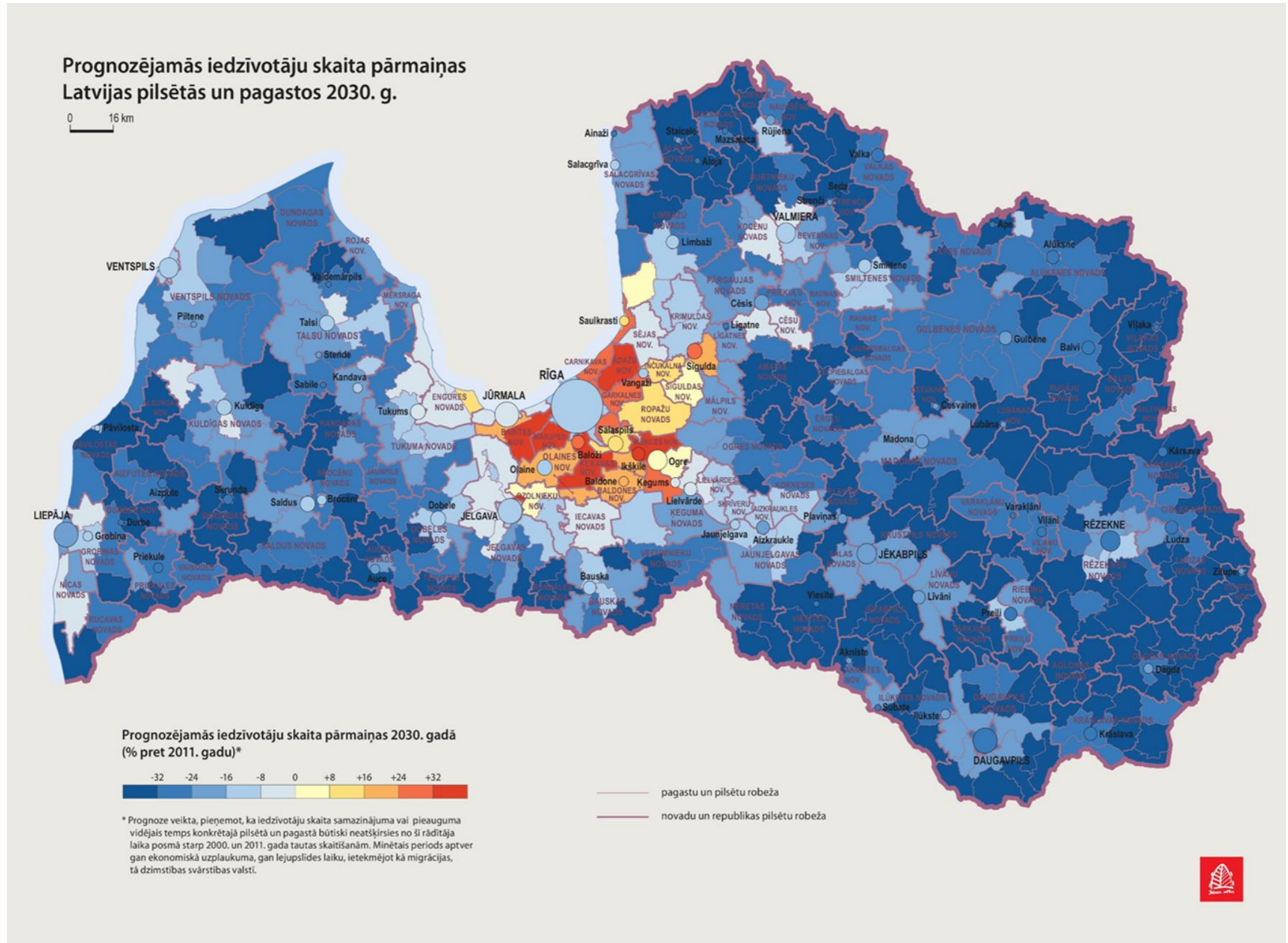


Population fluctuations in Riga

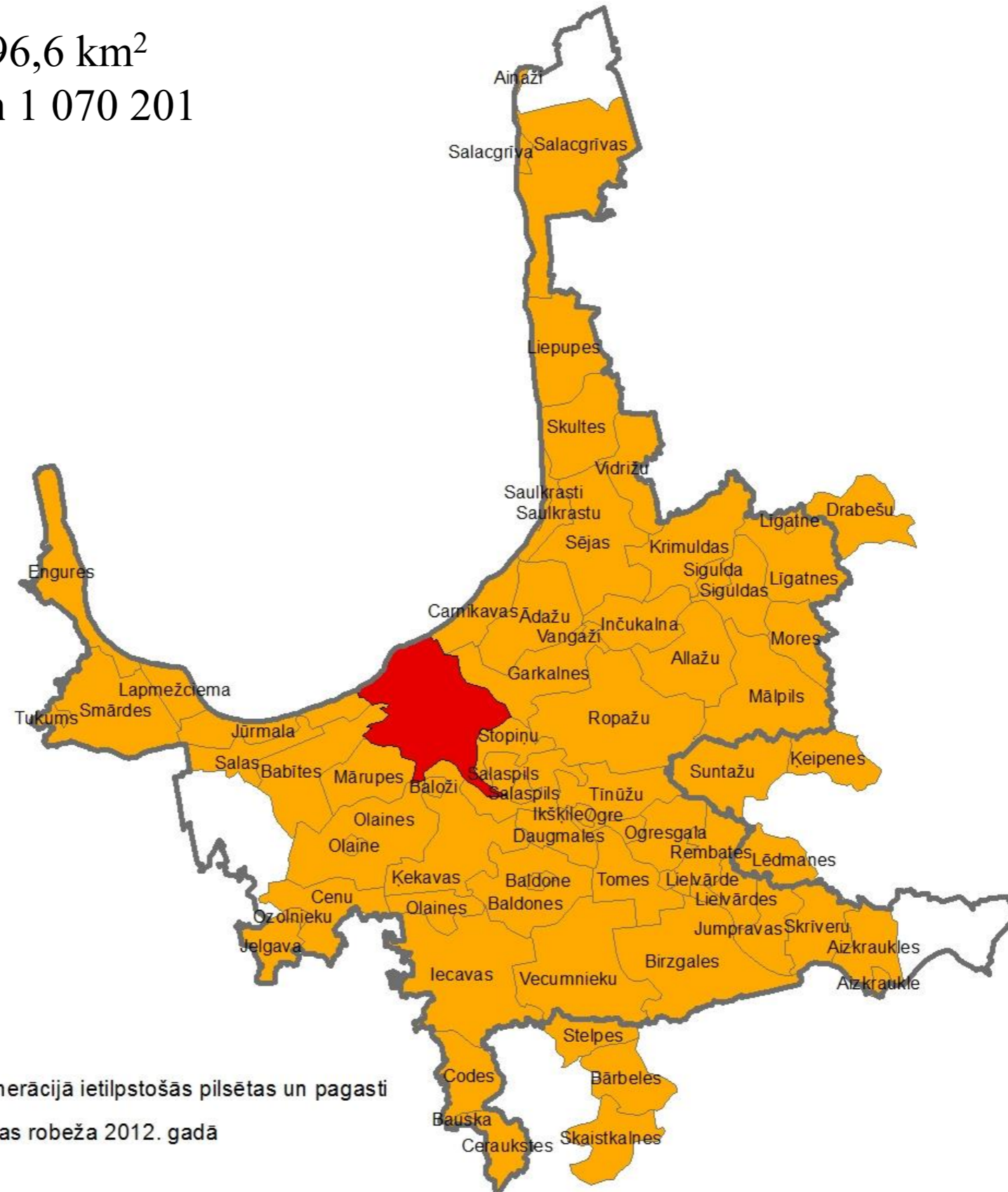

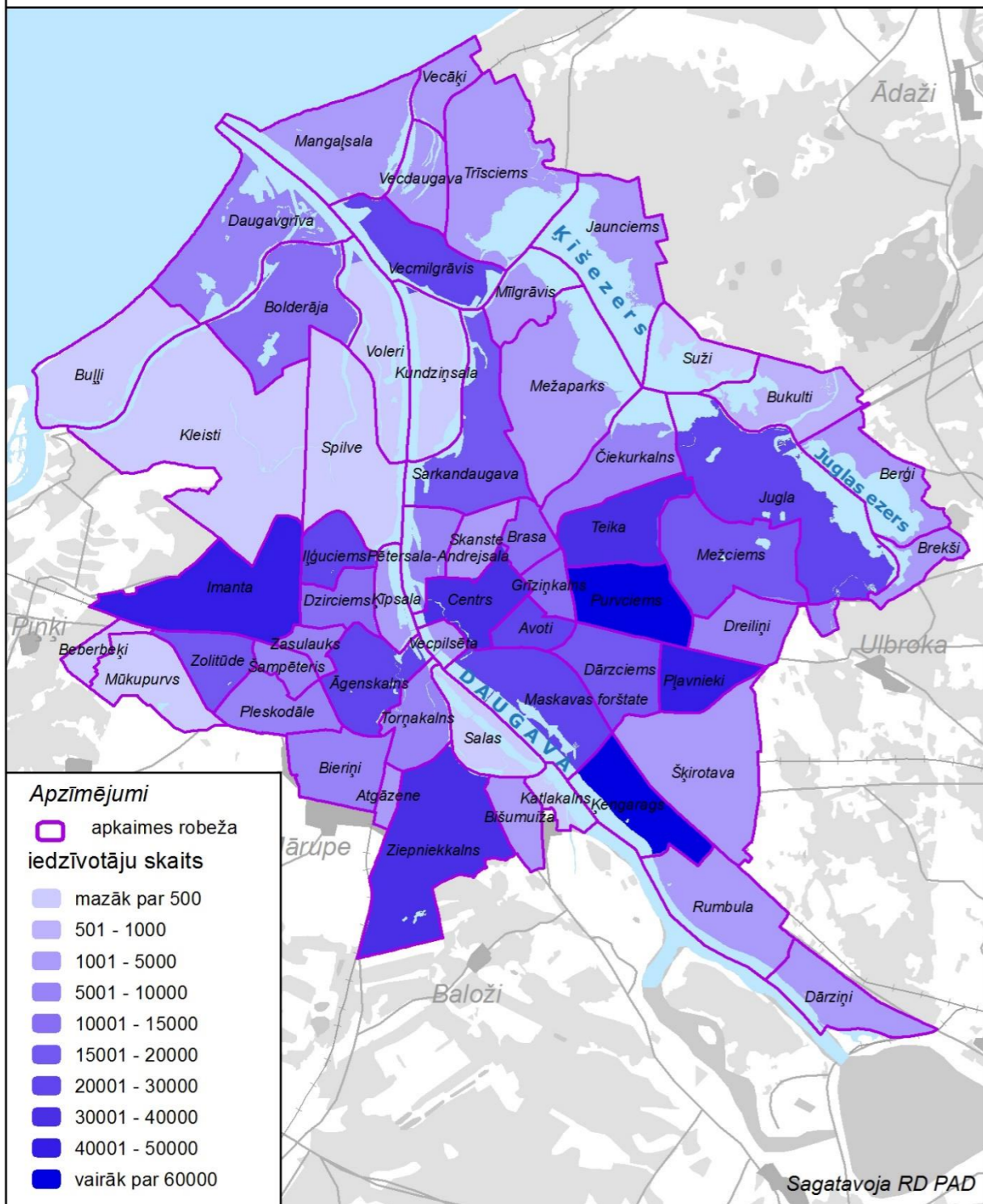

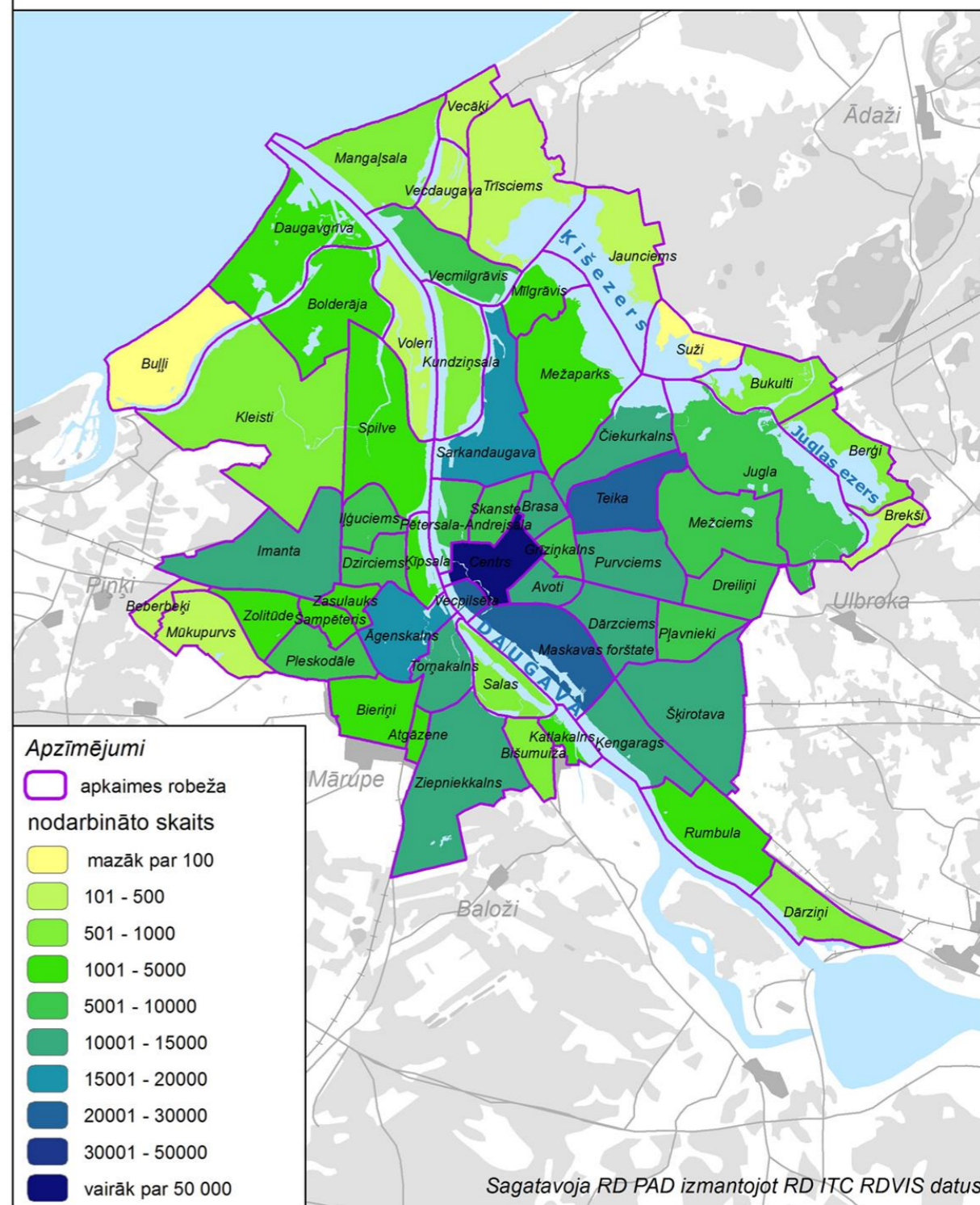

Iedzīvotāju skaits Rīgas apkaimēs, 2017

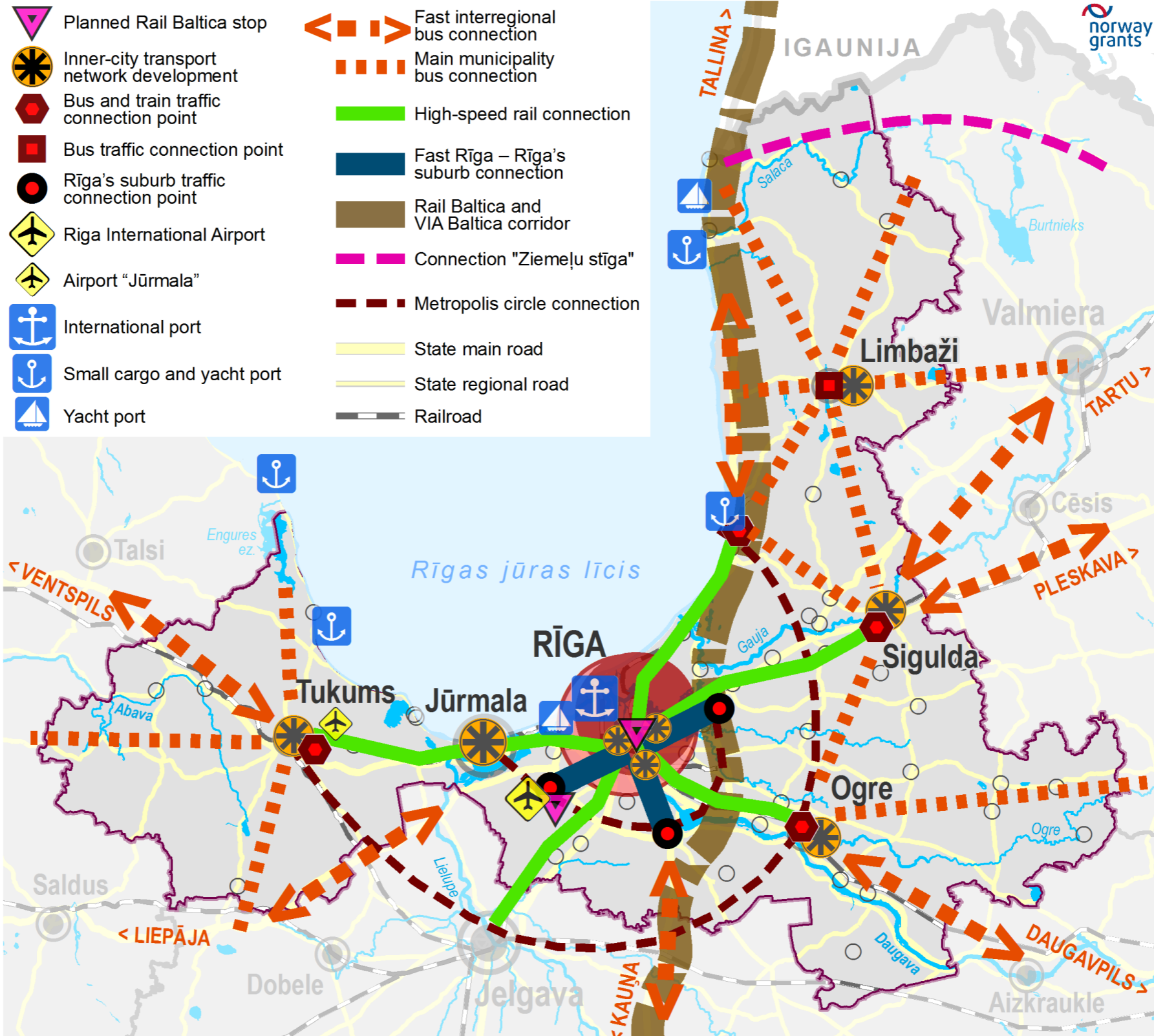


Nodarbināto skaits Rīgas apkaimēs, 2013





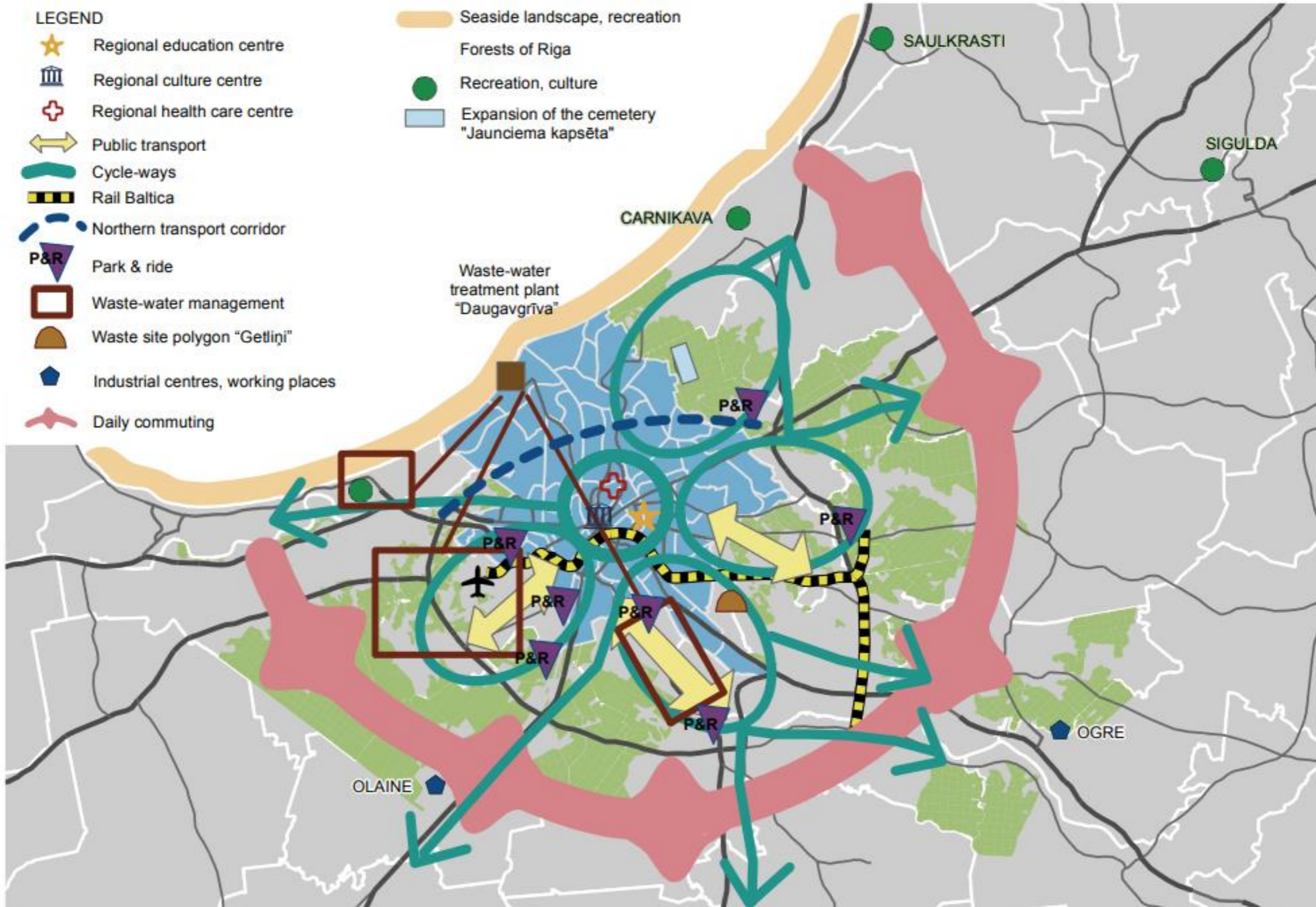

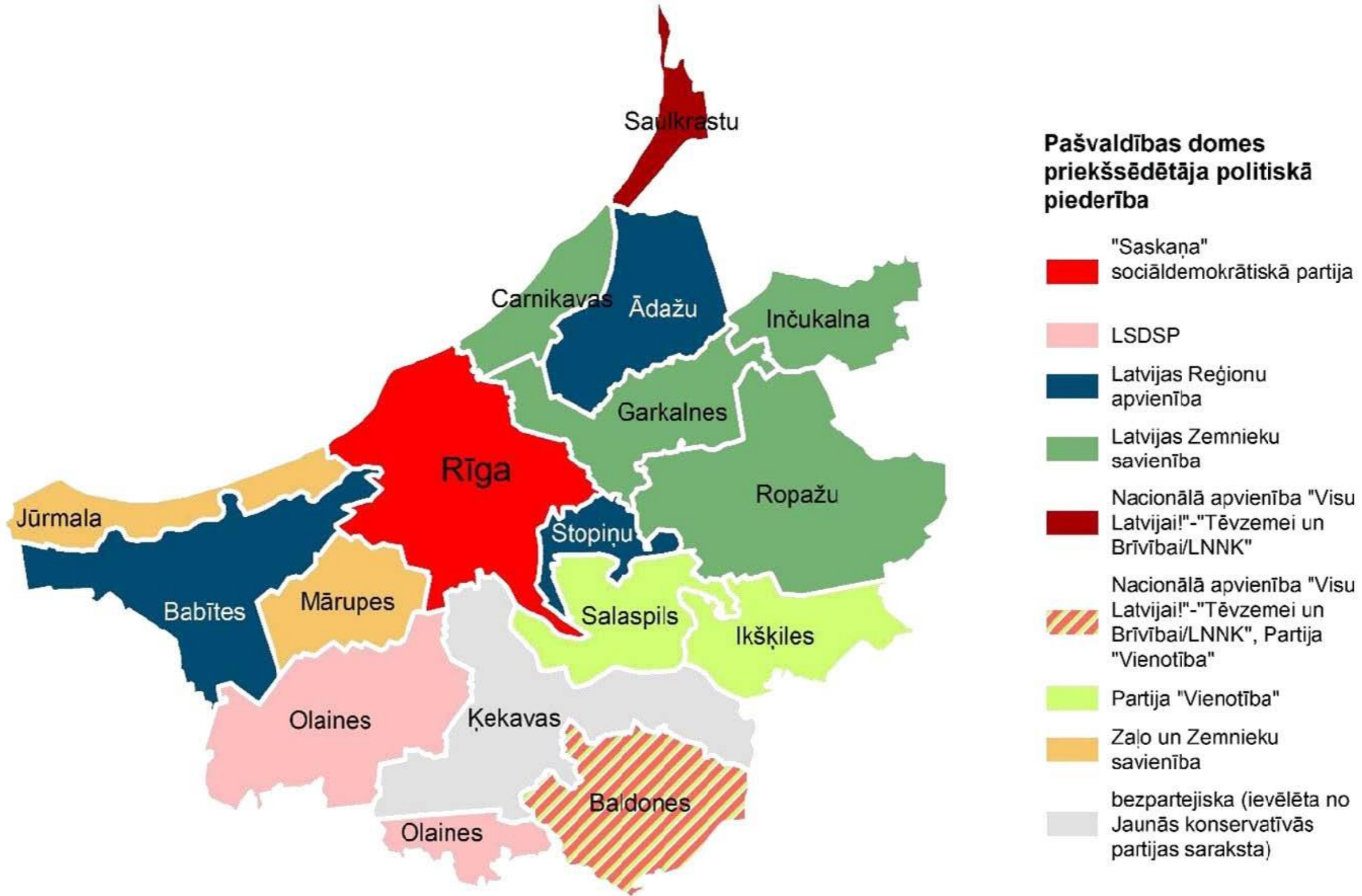


Main cooperation directions of the municipality of Riga with surrounding municipalities





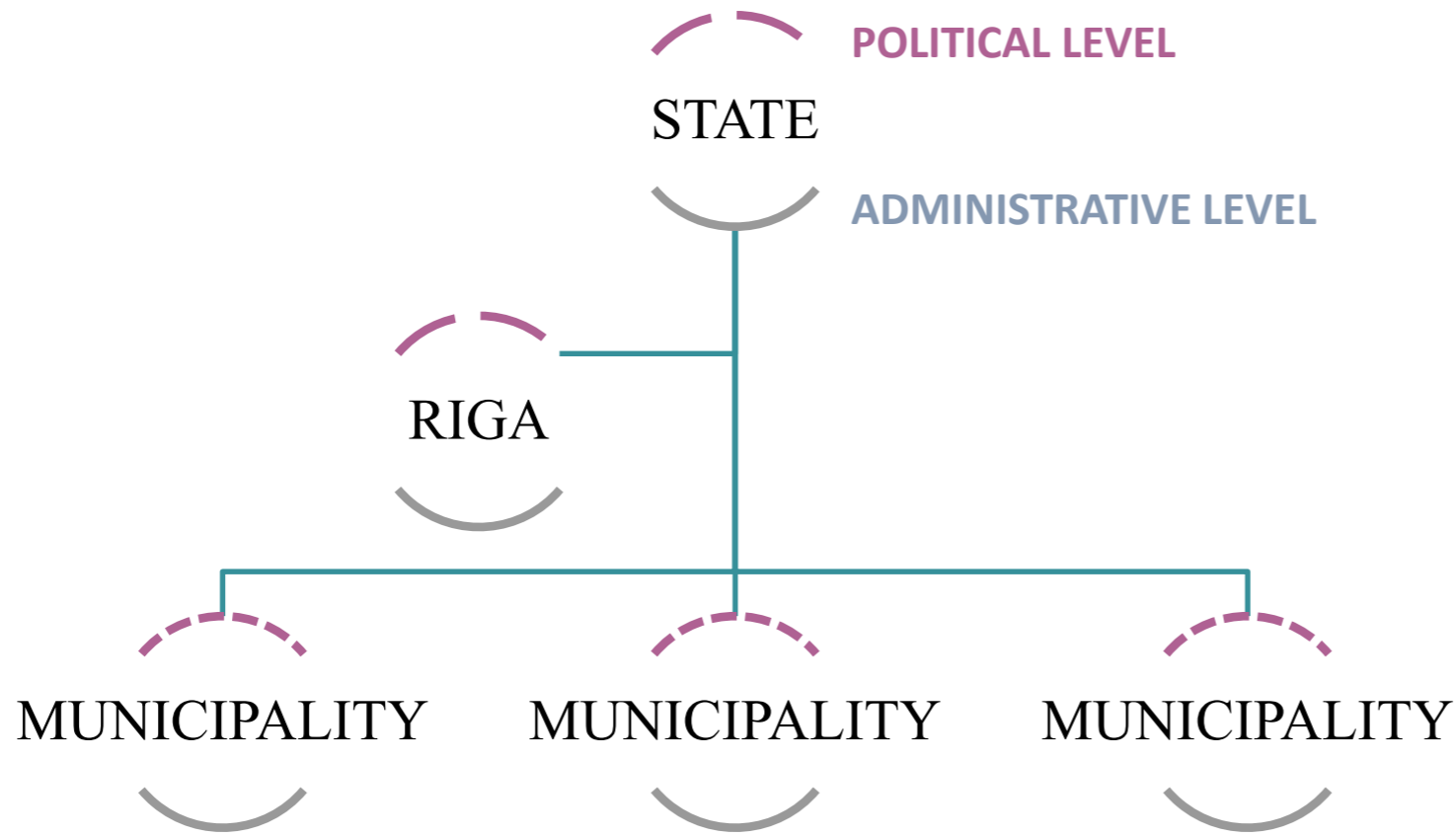

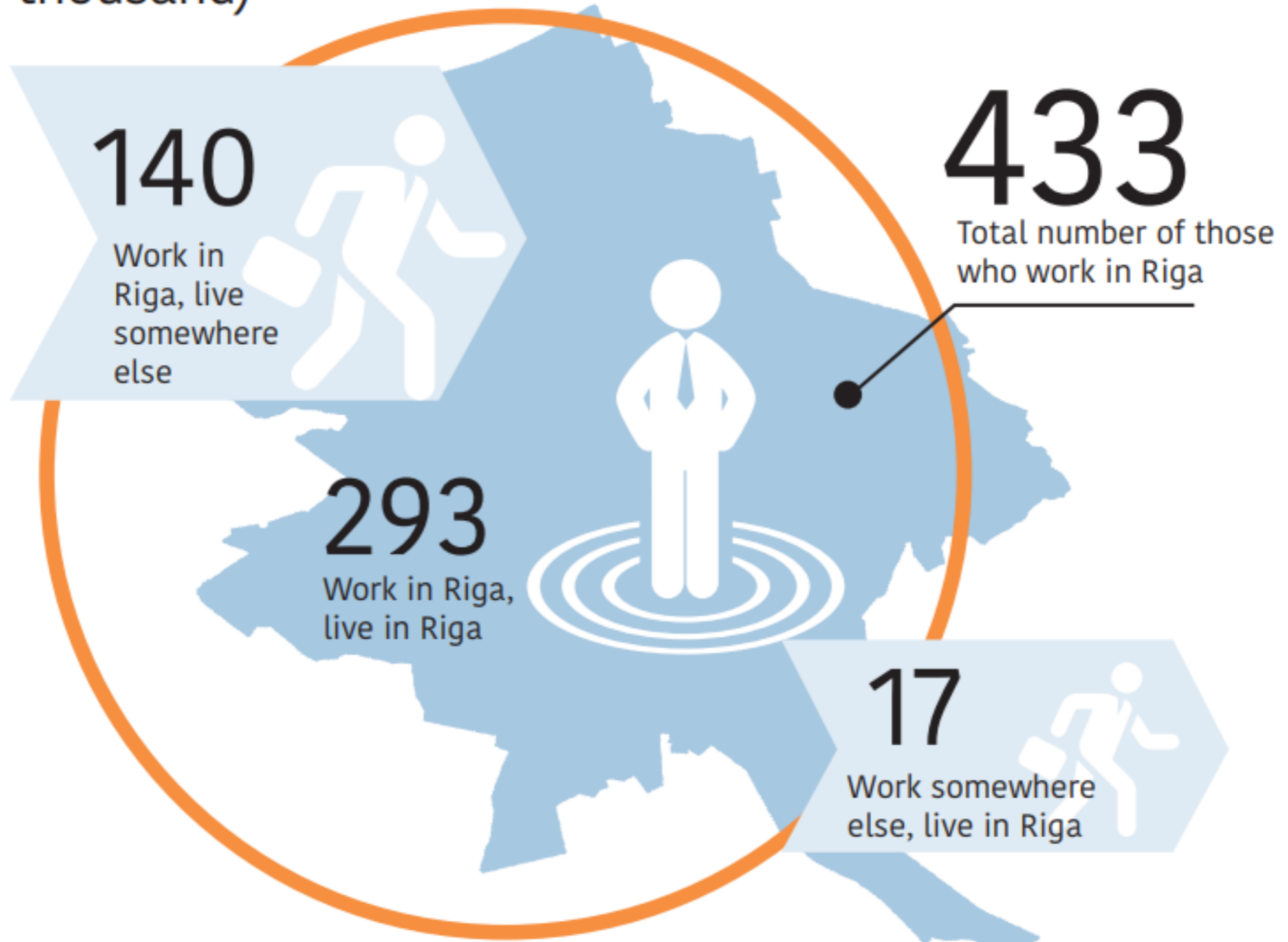

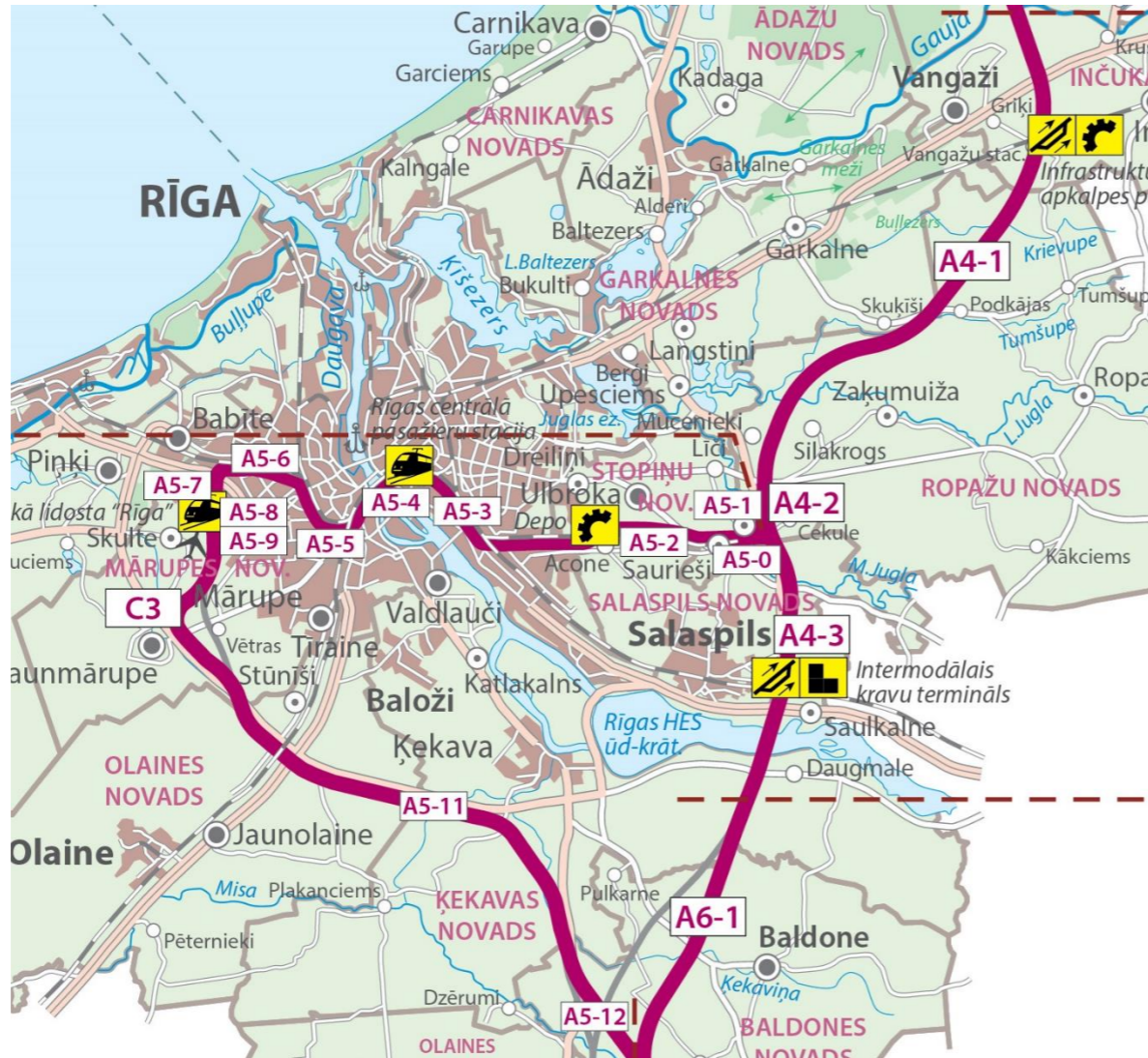

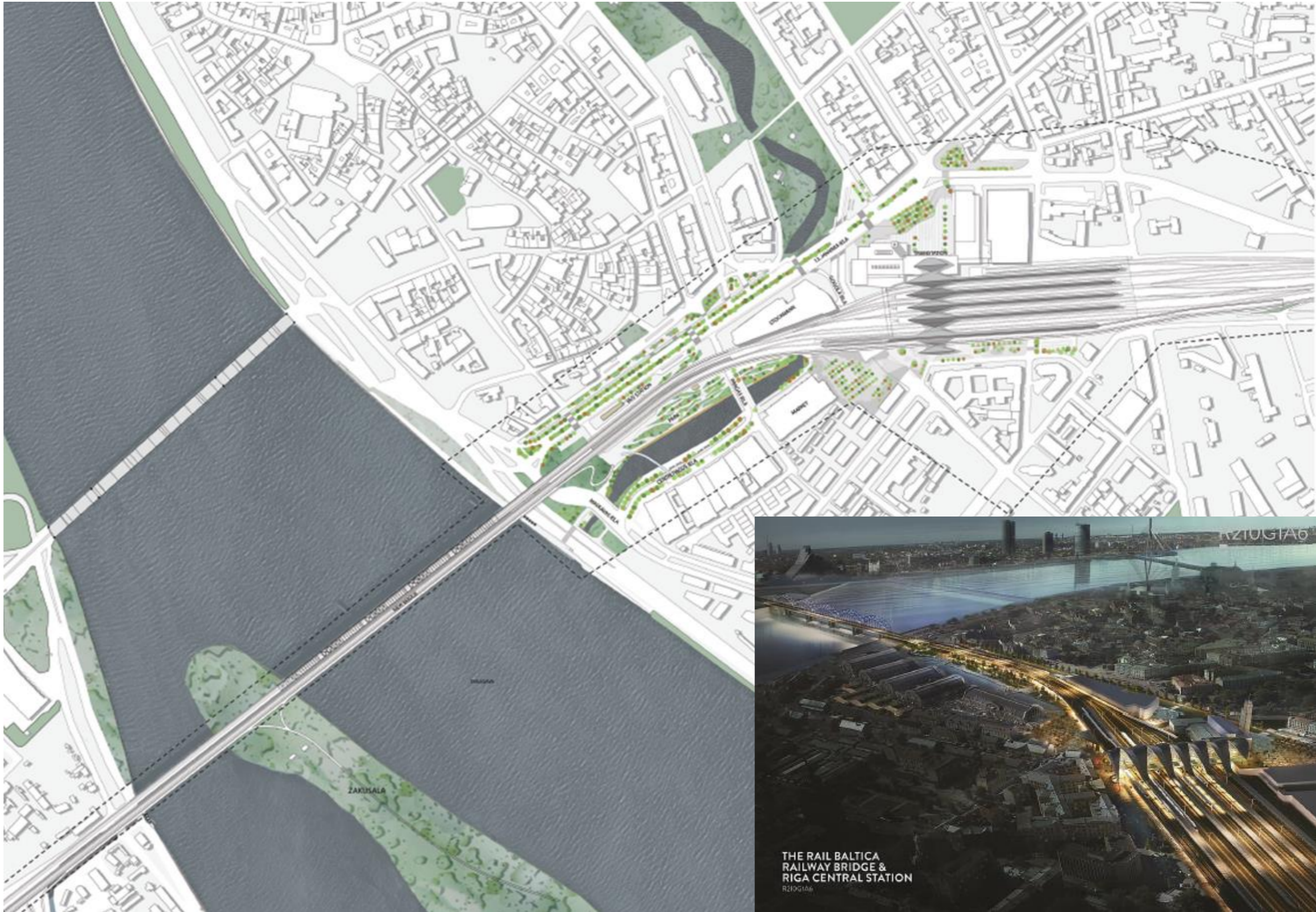
